Highlights of Calaca

2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH)

Date of Release: 16 September 2021

Reference No. 2021 - 3156

- The population of Calaca as of 01 May 2020 is 87,361 based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH). This accounts for about 3.00 percent of Batangas population in 2020.
- The 2020 population of Calaca is higher by 5,502 from the population of 81,859 in 2015, and 16,840 more than the population of 70,521 in 2010. Moreover, it is higher by 28,872 compared with the population of 58,489 in 2000. (Table 1)

- The population of Calaca increased by 1.38 percent annually from 2015 to 2020. By comparison, the rate at which the population of the municipality grew from 2010 to 2015 was higher at 2.88 percent. (Table 2)

- Among the forty (40) barangays of Calaca, Dacanlao had the biggest population in 2020 with 6,308 persons, followed by Pantay with 6,201 persons, Salong with 4,881 persons, Camastilisan with 4,172 persons, and Cahil with 3,818 persons. (Table 3)

- Munting Coral was the fastest growing barangay in the municipality with an annual population growth rate (PGR) of 5.76 percent from 2015 to 2020. It was followed by Barangay 3 (Pob.) with a PGR of 5.34, Puting Bato East with 4.96 percent, Madalunot with 4.88 percent, and Balimbing with 1.54 percent. Barangay 4 (Pob.) posted the lowest barangay PGR of -5.05. (Table 4)

- Calaca is composed of 40 barangays.
- Among barangays of Calaca, the largest in terms of population size is Dacanlao with 6,308 persons, followed by Pantay with 6,201 persons, Salong with 4,881 persons, Camastilisan with 4,172 persons, and Cahil with 3,818 persons. (Table 5)

- Barangay 3 (Pob.) has the smallest population with 356 persons, followed by Munting Coral with 505 persons, Balimbing with 610 persons, Barangay 6 (Pob.) with 752 persons and Barangay 2 (Pob.) with 798 persons. In the tenth place for least populous barangay is Makina with 1,270 persons. (Table 6)
